- Sunset at Hemakuta Hill: Hemakuta Hill in Hampi offers breathtaking sunset views, framed by ancient temples and boulders

- Stone Chariot at Vijaya Vittala Temple: An iconic stone chariot and the renowned Vijaya Vittala Temple complex, displaying architectural marvels
